

The Paralympics' Official Video Game launches in-game competitive Parasports Grand Prix tournament and daily real world updates for its online mobile community

The Pegasus Dream Tour's interactive Parasports Grand Prix begins on August 25th – experience all the excitement of the Paralympics on your mobile!

The first ever official video game of the Paralympics 'The Pegasus Dream Tour', created by JP Games, is synchronizing with the real-world event to allow players to experience all the excitement of the games through the medium of an online multiplayer community – all on your mobile phone.

With in-person attendance to this year's Paralympics not possible, the game gives fans of the Paralympics the opportunity to come together in the virtual setting of Pegasus City, watch highlights from the real-life games and participate in their own competitive Parasports Grand Prix tournament.

In line with the start of the Paralympic games the '**Pegasus Parasports Grand Prix**', the largest official tournament, will run from **August 25th to Sunday September 5th**.

Players will be able to take part in competitive virtual parasport matches across 5 events: boccia, 100m sprint, wheelchair basketball, wheelchair racing, and football 5-a-side. Those hoping to achieve gold will have their own chance at glory with in-game medals awarded based on the total points earned during the competition.

Daily highlights from the heated competition in Tokyo will also be broadcast onto the main screen found in the centre of Pegasus City every day during the Paralympics. Highlights will be updated every day from Wednesday 25th August. Player's avatars or 'Mines' can express themselves and show their support through stamps and emotes while watching the hotly-contested events.

Furthermore, the latest Paralympic updates will also be delivered as news flashes within the Pegasus Dream Tour, keeping players up to date with breaking news from the Paralympics whilst enjoying the game.

Much like the real-world Paralympics as the games wrap up, visitors to Pegasus City will also be able to enjoy a spectacular Parasports Grand Prix closing ceremony on **Sunday September 5th**. RPG avatars of the Japanese stars Virtual DREAMS COME TRUE will perform a free in-game virtual concert 'Let's Evolve!'.

A total of 9 real Paralympic athletes' avatars, such as the boccia player Hirose Takayuki, the wheelchair basketball player Patrick Anderson, the javelin thrower Holly Robinson, and the football 5-a-side player Silvio Velo, will also appear in the ceremony in their avatar form.

From Tuesday, August 24th and Saturday, September 4th, players can participate in an tap mission game in which you use Doraemon's gadget called the "Material Converter" to build a stage for the ceremony, earn original outfits, Virtual DREAM COME TRUE themed emotes and VIP Area Access for the virtual concert.

Limited-time rewards include groovy disco outfits, the caps of the original characters Dorikuma and Warukuma from Virtual DREAMS COME TRUE and other rare items. For more details, please visit the concert special site. <https://pegasus-dream.com/en/gala-party/virtual-dreamscometrue/>

Virtual DREAMS COME TRUE Profile

“DREAMS COME TRUE’s Virtual Characters” transcend into the digital dimension. Known by fans as “The Other DREAMS COME TRUE,” Virtual DREAMS COME TRUE also appeared in DREAMS COME TRUE WINTER FANTASIA 2020 - DOSCO prime Niconama PARTY !!!-, DREAMS COME TRUE 's first online event tour. The members’ names, MASADO and MIWASCO, are portmanteaus taking the MASA from Masato Nakamura and MIWA from Miwa Yoshida, and combining them with DOSCO (DREAMS COME TRUE Disco).

DREAMS COME TRUE Profile

DREAMS COME TRUE is a group comprising Masato Nakamura (bassist, composer, and arranger) and Miwa Yoshida (vocalist, composer, and performer). With this duo at its core, DREAMS COME TRUE has been flexibly adapting to the times in terms of music composition. In particular, the group’s music has taken a new direction since 2019, the 30th anniversary of their debut. In the single “YES AND NO/G” released in 2020, they created a novel sound that foreshadowed the group’s own imminent evolution, and in their latest album, “DOSCO prime,” the duo deconstructed their own music before reconstituting it again through a conversion-based approach. On September 22nd (Wednesday), DREAMS COME TRUE will be releasing their new song, “Tsugi no se no! -ON THE GREEN HILL DCT VERSION-” (a tie-up track for Ito En’s “Oi ocha”)!

This new release is made possible by an unprecedented three-way collaboration between Japan’s national brand “Oi ocha,” the world-famous character Sonic the Hedgehog, and DREAMS COME TRUE, and it will serve as a multiverse-like work that bridges the group’s past and future. Masato Nakamura has also composed and arranged the music for the timeless mega-hit game “Sonic the Hedgehog 1&2.” “Emerald Hill Zone” will be used for the Hollywood blockbuster “Sonic the Hedgehog 2 (2022) - Title Announcement - Paramount Pictures,” which will be released next year, while “Star Light Zone” was featured during the parade of athletes at the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games, which caught the attention of many people.

About “The Pegasus Dream Tour”

The Pegasus Dream Tour is the world’s first official Paralympic game. It was developed with the goal of branding the Paralympics in a new way and tackling social issues in a sustainable manner through the gaming experience of players.

The game is set in the virtual city of “Pegasus City,” which serves as a testing ground for a utopian future. Doraemon, one of Japan’s most iconic characters, will serve as the deputy mayor of this futuristic city, where a totally new experience offered by this “massive avatar RPG” awaits. The game features the dynamic advanced avatar “Mine” whose aim is to become a successful para-athlete alongside its friends, giving players the chance to support and develop their own personalized “Mine.”

In addition to being a place where players can enjoy para-sports, Pegasus City also serves as the site of various initiatives and endeavors aimed at creating a better future. By encouraging collaboration between different people, companies, and characters, Pegasus City will continue to evolve and become a harbinger of a better future.

The Pegasus Dream Tour is founded on an entirely new concept where players make a positive impact on the world and tackle social issues through gaming, allowing them to be involved in social good on an individual basis.
